It is with a kind of mixed feelings of delightment some sort of discouragement at the same time a self-satisfaction and a deep sense of gratitude that **ASHA** presents it's Annual Report for the year 2021-2022.

Feelings of delightment because over the years that had gone by "ASHA" has struck its deep roots and spend its branches among the Rural communities especially among the backward communities beyond the expectations and perceptions of its founding members and those who co-operated it in the initial stages of its origin and expansion.

The Association for the Social, Educational and Charitable Activities of the Poor Communities (ASHA), Renigunta is a Non Governmental Voluntary Organization established in the year 1978 and working in remote areas of Chittoor District in Andhra Pradesh, India.

Since for the past 44 years the ASHA is active in the task of empowerment of women and children in rural and backward areas. The services of the ASHA touched the under privileged women and children in slums areas of Renigunta Mandal of Chittoor. The main objective of the Association is to improve the living conditions of rural and unprivileged people by developing environmentally sound land and water resources programmes, improve the environment and eco-system, arrest the distress migration, improve the socio-economic status of rural people and strive for their overall development. The ASHA team also tried to promote and create awareness about environment conservation, health & nutrition and build sensitization on issues revolving around poverty, hunger and peace.

The Association works in one of the mostly backward district of Andhra Pradesh where more than 50% of the population is rural and tribal people who, due to their isolation and lack of awareness, have been cut off from the mainstream of society and deprived of the basic amenities of life. We work in 12 villages in 05 Gram Panchayats of Renigunta Mandal of Andhra Pradesh reaching out to 3100 households. We plan our activities based on analysis of the socio-economic contexts and the community dynamics of the area, with emphasis on community empowerment. Our programmes are unique in the sense as it is basically directed towards involving Community Based Organizations in every aspect including project planning, implementation, monitoring and management.

OUR VISION:

Provide multi-dimensional support for the entire family and not just for the woman. Research and develop innovative solutions to the problems of the urban poor. OBJECTIVES OF "ASHA":

- The Association is a voluntary social service organization works to bring social awareness and development among the under privileged sections of the society, irrespective of caste, creed, religion, and language etc., to establish equality and social justice.
- ➤ The Association contributes its efforts, skills, techniques and strategies to develop communities at the basis of society involving a combination of social, economical, cultural educational, health etc., development oriented activities to make the women cooperative, self reliant and independent.
- ➤ The Association will provide encouragement and guidance to interested children and groups to have deep understanding of the complex problems of development, humanity and social justice and of the functioning of the society in which they live. To have a clear vision of the type of society they want built by realistic plan of action with proper strategies and techniques.

ASHA believe that children must be given constant and continuous encouragement to participate in the developmental activities. Children can play a passive role in the social action, but we believe that children must be released to play their pivotal role as good citizens. We motivate children to participate in the developmental activities by conducting vocational training and non-formal educational classes.

MANAGEMENT:

The responsibilities of Management are on the Executive Body of the association and its staff. The Executive Body consists of 07 members with varied backgrounds such as social work, academic, administrative, accounts and medical. The chief executive of the society is the President. The association has its own rules and regulations that are helpful in administration.

PHILOSOPHY AND IDEOLOGY:

ASHA is particular that the possibility of developments is only through the active participation of the people. Motivation and awareness building are the important approaches of the organization in enlightening the people. The organization's role in the development process is to guide people along with initial economic support to make people self-reliant and self-sufficient. Dependency nature will be discouraged at the initial stages by careful observation and canalization. The root causes of exploitation and backwardness are ignorance, poverty, unemployment and oppression

GRANTS

SAFE AND CLEAN DRINKING WATER BOREWELLS PROGRAMME FOR THE REMOTE WATER SCARCITY COMMUNITIES.

We all need clean water, water that is free of potentially dangerous contaminants, which can be used for drinking, cooking, cleaning and bathing. The ASHA implemented the Safe and Clean Drinking Water Borewells Programme for the remote Water Scarcity in 10 villages of Renigunta Mnadal of Chittoor District. Nearly 1800 families are now able to have clean drinking water sufficiently. All the benefited families expressed their whole hearted regards and gratitude towards ASHA and the Donor. This programme was financially supported by BRILLIANT OUT COMES, UNITED KINGDOM, for installation of 10 Drinking Water Bore Well along with Hand Pump. The ASHA also conducted Health and Hygiene Awareness Generation Camps in these 10 villages.

The HANDLOOM WEAVING PROJECT was implemented for 30 rural poor women of Veparala Village of Jamalammagudu Mandal, Y.S.R. Kadapa District. **THE ASSOCIATED COUNTRY WOMEN OF THE WORLD**, **LONDON** has provided financial support for this programme. One month skill training was giving to the trainees on handloom weaving. A Skilled Master Weaver/Trainer Instructor was appointed for this programme, in order to teach the modern methodologies, innovative strategies, impressive and profitable methods.

During the training period **ASHA** distributed all the required raw materials like yarn, colour threads, etc., and tools to all 30 target women. All the 30 target women obtained Handloom Weaving Training and started their own production.
